**SPECIAL GAMES** The Kiwanis Div. 34 Special Games XXXII welcomed about 120 buses ferrying 900 athletes to the DeAnza College track. The Games begin with a formal opening ceremony and Parade of Athletes. Each athlete is placed in a group with similar abilities, and four events appropriate to those abilities are chosen for each group. The events are tailored to fit the limitations of these athletes. Every athlete is presented a T-shirt and a participant ribbon. About 4,500 ribbons are given out. The Games will be run by about 200 Kiwanians, 200 Kiwanis SLP members, and over 1,000 school and community volunteers. The first Kiwanis Special Games were played on March 29, 1979 on the Foothill College Fields. The Games were organized by Los Altos Kiwanian Walter D. Chronert, and Betty Fairchild and Sue Carr Katra, adaptive PE teachers.
